Please note the group photo will be taken by Green Screen Technology. The new green screen technology used in the year group photos now supersedes the previous style of photos using a large stage set up. The 'green screen' composite photo allows us to capture a clear image of each student and then edit them together negating the need for all the students to be together. This has been important due to Covid and minimizes the time away from the classroom for each student. The resultant photo is the same layout as the traditional style.
