Practice healthy eating and drinking habits - stay hydrated throughout the day and get enough nutrients to stay energized and boost your productivity.

Keep your space organized - having a clean and organized workspace can eliminate stress and make it easier to focus on the tasks at hand. Take some time each day or set a specific time every week to organize your desk and tidy up your workplace.

Network more often - make a point to engage in a certain number of networking opportunities each month.

What they used to do...

Welcome to our new feature which spotlights our current staff and where their career has led them and how they arrived at Stowmarket High School.

This week we sat down with Ms Relf to find out just **'What She Used To Do!'**



What did you use to do before you worked at Stowmarket High School?

I left school at 17 with 9 good GCSEs, my parents wouldn't let me go to college or uni to do my A levels because they didn't think I'd stick at it (it was a different time back then!) I went to work in an accountant's office doing basic office work. The following years are full of secretarial, admin and jobs in call centres. It was not until I was made redundant in 2004 that I decided to undertake study to gain a degree. That began the meandering pathway to my teaching career.

What did 10-year-old you want to be when they grew up can you remember?

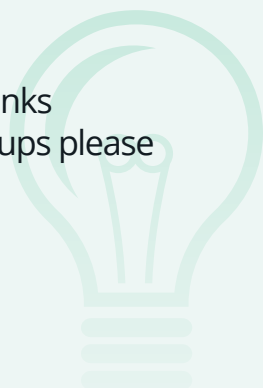
