## Headteachers' Blog

In my last Newsletter I said I was meeting County officials to discuss the expansion of the school, and that I would update your good selves when I knew more. Well, nothing is finalised, but the basic picture is that the school is projected to grow considerably over the next decade. There is some classic irony here – the old school was built to hold 1,400 – the new one 1,125. County tell me we will be at least at 1,400 – largely due to the expansion of the town – not including the effect of a successful school on parental decisions. We all ask the same question - 'If they knew the town was growing so quickly, why would they reduce the capacity of the school?' That is short termism for you.

County have now assessed our site and will start to work on a plan that will see us grow – the difficulty lies around our specialist rooms – food, design, drama, music etc. They are all going to need to be added, without splitting up our existing departments - many beard scratching moments on the way.

#### **Trauma Informed**

We have committed to become an accredited 'Trauma Informed' school by September 2024. Our recent training day was focussed on this, and there is, and has been, numerous individual training programmes contributing to our development. I thought at this stage it might be useful to clarify a couple of key points -

Trauma Informed does not mean that all our staff will be qualified to counsel the most affected students.

It does mean we will collectively offer a more supportive environment for all students

It does not mean that we will stop using sanctions against students who misbehave. All students most know that poor behaviour will have consequences.

Trauma is caused by not just the most horrible of events – it can be any event or sequence of events that significantly impacted an individual, and which remain unresolved.

With many experts citing a post pandemic spike in mental health challenges for young people, it seems sensible to me that we try to respond proactively.


