Ski Trip to Ehrwald, Austria - Behaviour Policy/Statement

The Ski Trip is intended to be an extremely enjoyable experience, providing an opportunity for all concerned to visit another country, see new sights, learn new skills, socialise and have a lot of fun.

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable environment, certain expectations of behaviour must be adhered to, and rules abided by.

It is far more productive and beneficial for all concerned to work together and not to adopt a 'them and us' type of attitude. In the light of recent litigation, and the difficulties associated with taking school trips, I hope you will support me in promoting the following criteria in order to ensure a safe and successful trip, which I expect all students to accept.

- Instructions given by staff and ski instructors must be obeyed without question.
- All students should comply with standards of behaviour laid down by the School and the Hotel management.
- There will be no drinking of alcohol.
- If a student refuses to comply with or disobeys a member of staff or a ski instructor, and promotes a situation which could be potentially dangerous to either themselves or to others, it is possible that their evening entertainment or ski pass will be withdrawn.
- If the situation necessitates, parents and/or the Headteacher will be contacted with regard to the appropriate course of action, which may involve sending the pupil home at the parents' expense.

I have been running the school Ski Trip for the last 12 years. So far there have been very few problems, none of which detracted from the overall enjoyment or safety of the trip. Sadly, in today's climate, it is necessary to make all concerned fully aware of expected standards of behaviour and codes of conduct.

Consequently, we would like you and your son/daughter to sign below as an acceptance of and agreement to, these expectations.
