Dear Families

I am pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to take part in a residential school trip to Bawdsey Manor PGL in Suffolk from. This has been a regular location for a number of our residentials now. The students will spend one night in tented accommodation and take part in a number of outdoor adventurous activities. Due to the size of the year group, they will be split into two visits and will either stay over on Wednesday 5th July or Thursday 6th July.

What does it cost?

What do I need to do next?

The cost of the trip is £145, there are 144 spaces available. Please log on to ParentPay and complete the permission, online medical consent and to secure a place on the trip, we would ask for a non-refundable deposit of £25 to be paid by Friday 10th March. The remainder of the balance can be paid in instalments or complete payment by 30th June. Please note that once deposits have been paid to PGL they are not refundable and terms and conditions will apply.

If your child currently qualifies for free school meals, or has done in the past six years, we receive Pupil Premium Funding intended to support their education. Therefore, for qualifying students, we can offer reduced charges for trips and educational visits.
