

**Malaga Sports Tour March 2023 - Behaviour Policy**

The football and netball tour is intended to be an extremely enjoyable experience providing an opportunity for all concerned to visit another country, see new sights, learn new skills, socialise and have fun. However, in order to provide a safe and enjoyable environment, certain expectations of behaviour must be adhered to and rules abided by.

I hope you will support me in promoting the following criteria in order to ensure a safe and successful trip. It is expected that all students will abide by the following rules:

- Instructions given by teachers, InspireSport coaches, hotel staff, coach drivers and tour representatives must be obeyed without question
- As representatives of the school, students are expected to portray themselves in a positive manner and must not be drawn into any behaviour which shows the school in a bad light
- All students should comply with the standards of behaviour laid down by the school and the hotel management
- All rooms must be kept in an acceptable state and refundable deposits will not be returned if damage is caused
- There will no drinking of alcohol or smoking
- Students must not leave the hotel complex; use the swimming pools or go into the sea without staff consent and supervision
- When outside of the hotel complex and during free, time students should stay in small groups and be prompt for any meeting times set
- Students must carry their emergency contact card with them at all times
- At night students must be in their own rooms at the times stipulated by staff and must not move between rooms
- If a student refuses to comply with or disobeys a member of staff it is possible that their evening entertainment or participation in a fixture will be withdrawn
- If the situation necessitates, parents and/or the Headteacher will be contacted with regard to what course of action is appropriate. In serious cases this could lead to parents being required to make arrangements for their child to return home at their own cost

This form must be signed by both parents and students to ensure that the expectations for behaviour are very clear. We are confident that if this contract is adhered to then it will be a very enjoyable and rewarding trip for staff and students.
