Hi All,

What a whirlwind of a half term it has been, with some lovely sunny days keeping us company! We have had lots of trips, clubs, and charity events (and lots more planned) so I just wanted to say I really appreciate the support Stowmarket families give the school to aid local charities which are close to our hearts, such as the recent 'colour run' which recognises and supports one another at our time of need.

As we look to the next half term and darker colder evenings, it is important to reflect on where you can source additional support e.g. with uniform, applying for Free School Meals and/or study support. If you are struggling, please do reach out to the school via your child's Head of Year in the first instance to see what support is available to you and your family.

It is also a time to reflect on the first impressions we have all made this new school year and consider how to be even better as we move forwards in the year. Whilst the vast majority of students are keen to learn and engage with the schools' high expectations set of them, at times it is appropriate to have honest conversations when students fall short and/or are jeopardising their progress. It is important that in order to build resilience and get ourselves back on track, that we are honest with ourselves and seek support and guidance where necessary to ensure swift action is taken. For example, sanctions exist to teach us lessons, build resilience and give students reasonable chances to avoid and overcome situations along with providing an opportunity to discuss any support available. Equally, rewards exist to celebrate our students' contributions to day-to-day school life, both inside and outside of lessons and to recognise and promote these regularly each week.

A reminder that all staff and students have recently completed the annual acceptable use declaration. This is to ensure that we regularly talk about and understand online safety and how to safeguard our own profiles and settings to ensure we regularly review our awareness of the risks and dangers which arise from technology and the internet.

A big thankyou also to the hundreds of students that supported our recent open evening and open mornings, it is a great opportunity for parents to speak to the young people that make our school community what it is beyond the voice of its adults. A special shout out to Daisy, Harrison, Cameron, Jacob, Matilda and Isla for speaking so wonderfully about their experience at Stowmarket and making it a school other students want to join.
