KS4 Options Process

Year 9 students are at the start of the process of selecting their GCSE and BTEC options for Year 10. This is the most important stage in your child's education so far and we understand it can be an anxious time. Making the right decisions and choices is of vital importance. In Key Stage 4, you will be focused on the subjects/qualifications you are studying, and preparing for the examinations in Year 11. You will be taking courses that will help you to prepare for further study, maybe on an A-Level/Level 3 course at Sixth Form or at college, through an apprenticeship or studying T-Levels.

You will have received a booklet to guide you and your child through the subjects and courses available and to help you make an informed choice regarding the optional subjects your child may wish to study.
