## **RE: Year 11 Easter Success Sessions**

To support students in the build up to their final exams we will be offering a series of in-school success sessions over the Easter holidays. The aim of these is to consolidate students' knowledge and exam technique, along with increasing their confidence, at a critical point in the year.

Whilst sessions are open to all, students should speak with subject teachers about which they should attend and prioritise those that were highlighted on the letter that went home to all students last half term. There is no expectation for students to attend all sessions. They need to strike a balance between in school support, revision at home and rest/well-being.

Sessions will run from Tuesday  $2^{nd}$  April - Thursday  $4^{th}$  April and on Tuesday  $9^{th}$  and Wednesday  $10^{th}$  April. Sessions in the morning will run between 9am-11.30am, and in the afternoon between 12.00pm and 2.30pm. Those who are attending full days will need to bring a packed lunch with them and will be able to use the tables set up in the atrium as an eating area between sessions, however no food will be available to purchase.

On arrival students should enter the building through the main doors in the Atrium. There will be signin sheets, where students will need to put their name and the session they are attending. Students should use the central staircase in the atrium to access each session. They will also be required to sign out when they have finished their day.

Students are not required to wear school uniform.

Expectations around behaviour and conduct will be the same as if students were in school normally. Any student not meeting these will be asked to leave their session and will be unable to attend any further ones over the Easter period.
