Whilst we are aware of the areas for development the school is working closely with the School Improvement Board, Trust and United Learning to secure strong outcomes this summer and beyond.

Your feedback on the recent survey has been invaluable in us reflecting as a school on your thoughts and feelings towards the school systems, processes and methods to secure strong outcome and build character, resilience and kindness in your children.

We have taken on board the requests for more information around learning, assessment, and outcomes in order to keep you fully informed of how your child is performing in relation to their target grades and effort levels. The school's reporting has increased from once a year to three times a year, so we are hopeful with more support and guidance around use of G4S and parent's events that you will benefit from a greater understanding of your child's attainment and progress and what you can do at home to support them further.





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
