#### **Year 10 Work Experience – Safeguarding Information**

As students prepare for work experience, we ask that parents/carers discuss the following important safeguarding guidance with their child. This advice is also relevant for any student temporarily away from school (e.g., due to illness or dual placement).

Work experience gives students valuable insight into the workplace and helps them develop key skills like communication, teamwork, and confidence. While off-site, student safety and wellbeing remain our top priority.

To all Year 10 students: If you feel unsafe or something doesn't feel right, support is available:

Each placement has a named adult responsible for your welfare. Raise any concerns with them immediately.
