### Stowmarket Cricket Tournament

Under clear blue skies and sunshine, Stowmarket's young cricketers put on a spirited display in a thrilling three-match tournament, finishing a proud **second overall**.

#### Game 1: vs Thurston

The tournament began with a competitive clash against a **Thurston** team which were made up of older students. Stowmarket bowled well, with **Lewis** leading from the front — taking a wicket and holding **three outstanding catches** in the field. Despite a solid bowling effort, the **run chase fell just short**, with the **middle order struggling to build momentum**.

#### Game 2: vs Thomas Mills

Next up was **Thomas Mills**, where Stowmarket found their stride. A fantastic **opening partnership between Ben and Will** set the tone. Ben played a confident knock of **18**, while Will anchored the innings brilliantly with **39 not out**, helping the team to a strong total of **88 for 3 off 10 overs**.

With the ball, the team backed up their batting with another sharp performance — **Lewis again starred**, claiming **two key wickets**. The bowlers kept things tight, securing a **15-run win**.

#### Game 3: vs Stowupland



In the final game against **local rivals Stowupland**, Stowmarket's bowlers were dominant, restricting the opposition to just **33 for 5 from 8 overs** with Caleb taking two wickets in one over for only 1 run. The chase was calm and efficient, with **Bailey scoring a quick 15**, as the team knocked off the runs comfortably within **3 overs**.
