## GCSE Results – Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2025

GCSE results will be available for students to collect from 9.30am on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August. Students will need to be off site by 11:00am. Results will also be available online from 10.00am on the same day, via the Go4School website.

I would also like to remind you that if a student cannot collect their results in person and wishes to authorise a family member to do so on their behalf, we must receive written notification by Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> July. This must clearly state the name of the person who has been given permission to collect the results. If you have any questions, please contact Mr West by email.

On arrival, and prior to collecting their results, students will need to complete a destination form which is required by the school for Post-16 tracking.

There will also be a form in the envelope which should be completed once students have seen their results. This form is supplied by the exam boards and allows us to request scripts. We can then use these as exemplar material, anonymised, to support our teaching in future years. These scripts become an invaluable tool that future students can benefit from.

If a student feels that there has been a mistake made in the marking of any of their papers, then they can request a copy of the marked script. At that point, I would strongly urge the student to share this with their teacher and discuss the merits of seeking a remark or a clerical check whilst still on site. There are fees involved with these processes. More information on both remarking and clerical checks can be found on the school website.
