Year 11 GCSE Mathematics

The recent baseline assessment in Maths has helped to form part of our structured plan to help STUDENT enjoy success in their GCSE exams in Summer 2026.

To support this success, we have created a Personal Currency Plan (PCP) in Mathematics for STUDENT. This PCP highlights STUDENT's specific strengths and areas of development, by topic, based on their performance in this baseline assessment.

STUDENT should be given their PCP at some point this week along with some time in class being taught how to use it effectively and are being advised to take it home. I encourage you to ask STUDENT about their Maths PCP so that you can discuss the strengths and weaknesses, along with how STUDENT could work independently to address their areas for development. The associated codes next to each topic are linked to our homework platform Sparx Maths. This will enable STUDENT to address, with video support and practice, each weakness.

At school, we will continue to run our weekly Maths Success sessions on a Wednesday after school. I have attached the overview of the topics we are covering throughout the year - these have already been shared with the Year 11 students. STUDENT also has full access to both Sparx Maths and MathsWatchVLE.
