As we approach the end of term, we would like to confirm the arrangements for the final week of the Autumn Term and the start of the Spring Term in January.

### **Twelve Days of Christmas w/c Monday 15 December**

### **Christmas Lunch Wednesday 17 December**

Christmas lunch will take place on Wednesday 17 December for those who have chosen and paid for it. Food will still be available at break and lunchtime as usual from Lillie's. However, it will be a reduced lunchtime offer for students who are not having the Christmas lunch. Serving of the pre-ordered Christmas lunch will begin during period three and students will be called down by year group. Details will be given to students via their form tutors on the day.

### **Christmas Hampers Thursday 18 December**

On Thursday 18 December, we will hold our Christmas hamper event. Students have worked extremely hard on their creative designs and we remain very grateful for donations to date. Students can continue to bring donations up to and including Wednesday 17 December. All hamper contents will be donated to Stowmarket Foodbank to support families in our community.
