

The girls created numerous chances and were desperately unlucky not to score on several occasions, as Olaya Lopez-Senis struck the post on one occasion and Aaliyah hit the crossbar on the other. Following some excellent, composed midfield play, Olaya played a perfectly weighted through ball to Aaliyah Copland, whose powerful strike towards the top right corner was brilliantly tipped wide by the opposition's Norwich Academy goalkeeper.

Despite a relentless effort and an outstanding team performance, the scoreline remained 1–0 at full time. A valiant display from the girls, who can be proud of their performance despite being knocked out of the County Cup. They will now look to continue their strong form in the West Suffolk Cup after Christmas.
