Year 11 GCSE Mathematics

Following yesterday's Parents' Evening which we hope you found a worthwhile experience. The recent PRE exams form part of our structured plan to help your child enjoy success in their GCSE exams in the Summer. We hope that they have found the experience both helpful and informative.

If you were present at the evening, you would have been given a copy of the Personal Currency Plan (PCP) in Mathematics for your child. If you were unable to attend yesterday's event, we will give the PCP to your child and encourage them to take it home.

This PCP highlights their specific strengths and areas of development, by topic, based on their performance in the PRE exams across all their Mathematics papers, with relevant Sparx codes to help address these weaknesses. Your child will be familiar with this PCP as they already have a copy in school.

Whilst all the papers are relevant, using the paper 2 PCP first will help your child prepare for the forthcoming progress check paper at the end of January. The rest should be used ahead of the Spring term PRE exams.

I have also attached the guide to key dates and helpful revision sites that was shared with parents last night. These are excellent free resources and cover all aspects of the GCSE preparation, including exam questions, videos and worked solutions.

We also continue to run our weekly success session on a Wednesday after-school. I have attached the schedule for these topics as they focus on key areas that we know students often find harder. For some students, we will also organise additional support sessions, however we will contact students and parents directly about this.

As always, we are grateful for your continued support, and we know just how demanding these next few months can be. If you wish to discuss your child's mathematics further, please contact their maths teacher either by email or on the school number.
